Directions

From the Queen Elizabeth II (QE2) Highway


- Exit onto Whitemud Freeway going East
- Exit on 75 Street going North
- Turn left onto 112 Avenue going West
- Turn left on to 101 St. going South and turn right onto Kingsway Ave.

From Yellowhead Trail

- Exit 97 Street going South
- Turn right on Norwood Blvd. (112 Avenue) going West
- Turn left on to 101 St. going South and turn right onto Kingsway Ave.

Parking *IMPORTANT!*

- Two-level pay and display parkade in front of the Main Entrance. Upper level entrance off of 102 Street, lower level entrance off of 104 Street. Credit card/coin. \$2.00 per 1/2 hr. \$15 for 24 hour pass.
- Pay and display lots near the Community Services Centre. Enter off of 111 Ave. or Kingsway Ave. Credit card/coin. \$1.75 per ½ hr. \$13 for 24 hour pass.
- Parkade on the corner of 102 Street and Kingsway Ave. Access Pedway to ActiveTreatment Centre on third level. Enter off of 102 Street. Credit card/cash (pay when exiting). \$1.75 per ½ hr. \$13 for 24 hour pass.
- Parking rates are in effect 24 hours a day, 7 days
- Weekly parking passes are available at all Pay & Display Machines and upon exiting the S.E. Parkade. Monthly parking passes are available at the Cashier's Office on the Basement Level of the Active Treatment Centre or from the **Change Machines** Parking Office, Room 100, Materiel Management Centre (enter from the West side).
- Weekly and monthly passes valid at Pay & Display lots, and meters.
